

Background


- Youngest community foundation in SA
- Feasibility study undertaken in 2007 by Catherine Brown & Associates & funded by FRRR
- A steering committee was formed in 2007 to set up the structure of the Foundation. Board recruited and Fleurieu Community Foundation was officially launched in October 2010
- A part-time executive officer was employed in late April 2011 for 16 hours / week (but finished up in late Aug due to lack of ongoing funding)
- Corpus is \$122,500
